SCOPE

This policy applies to all employees of Hackettstown Regional Medical Center (HRMC).

PURPOSE

To outline policy and procedure for healthcare worker Influenza prevention.

POLICY

- I. Hackettstown Regional Medical Center (HRMC) has adopted 2.165 HEALTH CARE WORKER FLU PREVENTION PLAN. <u>https://intranet.adventisthealthcare.com/policiesandprocedures/Corporate/Human%20Resources%2</u> 0-%20Corporate/Occupational%20Health/AHC%202.165.pdf
- II. Employees exempt from receiving the flu vaccine shall wear masks during the active Influenza season. This season will be determined by the NJ Respiratory Virus Surveillance Report. A report of moderate level of virus activity in Warren County or any contiguous county will initiate the use of masks for these employees.
- III. The decision to discontinue wearing of masks will be based on the NJ Respiratory Virus Surveillance Report displaying at or below a low level of virus activity for 2 consecutive weeks in Warren County **and** contiguous counties.
- IV. Wearing of masks should continue until Occupational Health / Human Resources has communicated a date for discontinuation.
