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PURPOSE: To transport laboratory specimens to and from the laboratory.

SUPPORTING DATA: Federal Register DOL-OSHA 29 CFR Part 1910.1030

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Portable cooler(s) utilized by the laboratory for specimen transport will be clearly marked with a red-orange or florescent orange biohazard label.
- 2. The biohazard label will be clearly visible and affixed to the cooler in a manner that prevents its loss or unintentional removal.
- 3. The cooler(s) will transport only laboratory specimens (no food or beverages).
- 4. The cooler(s) will be cleaned weekly with a germicide approved by the HCH Environmental Services Department.
- 5. The cleaning will be recorded on a chart with date and initials of person performing the cleaning.
- 6. The cooler(s) will be checked monthly for damage to render the cooler unsafe, cracks/splits, and/or excessive wear.
- 7. If any cooler is damaged or deemed unsafe for specimen transport it will be replaced.
