PURPOSE

To provide a guideline for non-discrimination of patients.

POLICY

Hackettstown Regional Medical Center is a provider of health care services that receives federal funds under Medicare Part A and Medicaid. Accordingly, HRMC has a non-discrimination policy as required by Section 601 of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 45 C.F.R., Part 80, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

No persons shall, on the grounds of race, color, religion, age, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability or any other any other protected classification, be excluded from participation in, be denied benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination in the provision of any care or service.
