Weekly Status Checks

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SCOPE

All nursing staff in the Radiation Oncology Center

PURPOSE

To provide a policy on weekly status checks performed by the Radiation Oncologist and documentation of clinical findings (by both MD & nurse)

DEFINITIONS

N/A

POLICY

All patients are seen by a Radiation Oncologist each week during the course of treatment.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Patient weights will be done at initial consultation for baseline data and thereafter when appropriate. Blood tests will be performed per physician request.
- 2. Each week the Radiation Oncology Nurse assists the Radiation Oncologist in seeing patients in status check. The patient is seen immediately before or after his/her treatment, on the appropriate day. The nurse assists with any examination required.
- 3. The Radiation Oncologist is responsible for documenting the date of the status check and his/her findings.
- 4. The patient/family receives education and reinforcement of any physician instructions in symptom management. This information must be documented within the nursing notes.
- 5. A referral for dietary consultation should be made at this time, if not yet established during the consultation screening process and as appropriate.
- 6. Referral to social services will be performed as necessary by the physician and/or nurse.
- 7. Documentation within the Nursing care plan will be performed by the RN to record any nursing interventions.
