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Purpose: To identify, record and report any critical/abnormal results during pulmonary rehabilitation.

## Procedures:

- 1. Critical abnormal values resulting from outpatient pulmonary rehabilitation will be reported. The findings may be reported to the ordering physician, the patient's pulmonologist and/ or the physician covering the area.
- 2. The critical value will be reported within one hour of the finding/occurrence.
- 3. The communication will be recorded in the critical value log.
- 4. The following will be recorded:
  - a. Date/Time
  - b. Patient Name
  - c. Medical Record Number
  - d. Value/incident Reported
  - e. Physician notified
  - f. Action taken

## Critical values:

- a. Increase/ decrease in Blood Pressure of 20% compared to baseline.
- b. Sudden onset of shortness of breath
- c. Sudden onset of chest pain
- d. Increase/ decrease of heart rate of 20% compared to baseline
- e. Altered mental status
- f. Significant change in baseline oxygen saturation not related to activity.
- g. Sudden onset of severe pain
