## HACKETTSTOWN REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER LABORATORY POLICY MANUAL DRESS CODE

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**PURPOSE:** To establish a uniform dress code for laboratory personnel, which protects the staff and patients from bodily injury and contamination.

**POLICY:** All laboratory personnel will adhere to the general Hackettstown Regional Medical Center Dress Code, as described in the Employee Handbook. In addition, the following standards will apply:

## **Clerical and Phlebotomy Staff**:

- 1. Heels higher than two inches are not to be worn for safety concerns.
- 2. Clean neat laboratory coats or scrubs will be worn by phlebotomists.
- 3. Clean gloves are to be worn for all blood contact or specimen collections.

## Technicians/Technologists:

- 1. Hospital supplies lab coats are to be worn by all personnel performing testing.
- 2. Crepe, gum or rubber- soled shoes are acceptable. Well maintained white sneakers may also be worn. Hard soled shoes may be unsafe and should not be worn.
- 3. Open -- toe shoes may not be worn.
- 4. Long hair should be tied back so as not to be potentially dangerous when leaning over patients, equipment or specimens.
- 5. Gloves are to be worn for all invasive procedures and any time contact with blood or bodily fluids is anticipated.
