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PRINCIPLE: To establish guidelines for the disinfection of pneumatic tube carriers or

system...

PROCEDURE: Note: Always use Standard Precautions when handling carrier.

- 1. In the event that the carrier becomes contaminated with a spill remove contents if they are salvageable. Clean specimen containers with disinfectant and process as appropriate.
- 2. Replace foam liner with a clean one and disinfect soiled foam by soaking in hospital approved disinfectant and dry thoroughly.
- 3. Discard any foam liners that are soiled and cannot be cleaned.
- 4. In the event that the spillage has occurred outside the carrier, the entire tube system will need to be disinfected with a disinfecting carrier.
- 5. Notify the sending location to discontinue use.
- 6. Soak the disinfecting carrier in hospital approved disinfectant and shake off excess liquid.
- 7. Insert disinfecting carrier into the tube box and begin operation of the system according to SOP.
- 8. The decontamination procedure will be conducted several times and the lab will notify the emergency room when the system is ready for use.
