 - D. Urine dipstick by Clinitek Status Plus
 - E. Amnioswab for pH Nitrazine by ProLab (non-waived)
 - F. Amnisure for Ruptured fetal membrane by Amnisure (non-waived)
 - G. ACT by Hemochron Signature Elite (non-waived)
 - H. Whole blood Creatinine by Abbott IStat
 - I. Chem 8 and Troponin by Abbott IStat (Troponin non-waived)
