POLICY:

- 1. The following waived and non-waived tests are currently performed under the HRMC Point of Care Program:
 - A. Glucose Monitoring by Accucheck Inform Meter
 - B. Urine pregnancy by Quidel test kit.
 - C. Occult blood by Hemoccult card kit.
 - D. Urine dipstick by Clinitek Status
 - E. Amnioswab for pH Nitrazine by ProLab (non-waived)

- F. Amnisure for Ruptured fetal membrane by Amnisure (non-waived)
- G. ACT-LR by Hemochron Jr from ITC (non-waived) (non-waived)
- H. Whole blood Creatinine by IRMA TRUpoint from ITC (non-waived)
