TITLE: RESPONSE PLAN TO IN PATIENT HOSTAGE SITUATION

PURPOSE: To initiate an immediate response to hostage situations in order to aid in quick recovery of hostage

as well as minimizing danger to other patients.

LEVEL: Interdependent

**SUPPORTIVE** 

DATA: Although incidents are low, the effect of hostage taking is devastating to parents, staff and hospital

reputation

## CONTENT:

1. As soon as discovery of incident is known, Dial 6000, the operator will page **Dr. Strong**.

- 2. Nurse from the unit will:
  - a) Remove patient's and visitors from immediate area
  - b) Notify all nursing staff
  - c) Attempt to ascertain who is in the room (i.e. abductor, and number of hostages) and brief descriptions by questioning witnesses.
- 3. Security will notify police.
- 4. Once security is present nurses will:
  - a) Close off the unit to all incoming visitors
  - b) Determine if other patients and visitors should be removed from unit and the best place for relocation
- 5. Administration will notify additional law enforcement if needed.
- 6. Risk Management will notify Princeton Insurance Co. **Note:** No hospital employee is to give out any information refer to public relations.
- 7. Remove relatives/witnesses and other involved persons to another room providing one on one care using staff members known to them.
- 8. Nurse will screen all phone calls to involved persons (to protect from media and unwanted personal calls).
- 9. All staff members present or on duty at time of incident will:
  - a) Put into writing all memories of event and any description they recall.
  - b) Remain in the hospital until after police have had an opportunity to question them, even if this means over staffing.
- 10. Attempt to reassure relatives and involved persons present and keep them as informed as possible.
- 11. Be aware of staff reactions and be sensitive to their needs.
- 12. If at any time the incident escalates to an abduction, threat protocol should be initiated.
- 13. When incident is over and abductor is in custody and has left the building, the operator may announce, **Dr. Strong all clear.**
- 14. Counseling or referrals to social services may be provided to patient and family as needed.
