- 1. In cases of suspected abuse occurring within the last 72 hours, hospital personnel may receive direction regarding the transfer of the child for counsel and examination.
- 2. In cases occurring more than 72 hours ago DYFS may present documentation requesting the child be placed on administrative hold for up to (3) business days pending investigation and possible court appearance.
- 3. If a child is placed on an administrative hold, notify the on-call social worker. The social worker along with the nursing supervisor and administrator on-call will coordinate the specifics of the hold.
