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#### **SCOPE**

All RNs in Inpatient Areas

## **PURPOSE**

To provide guidelines to complete a Harris Flush.

# **POLICY**

Physician order needed.

# PROCEDURE

Equipment List:

- 1. Solution as ordered (tepid)
- 2. Disposable enema set
- 3. Gloves
- 4. Lubricant
- 5. Underpad
- 6. Paper Wipes
- 7. Bedpan
- 1. Assemble apparatus and prepare solution in enema bag. Solution is usually tap water or normal saline. Prepare in patient's bathroom.
- 2. Position patient in left Sims position.
- 3. Lubricate tube then gently insert 2-4 inches.
- 4. Hold enema container 12 inches above rectum. Instill 100-200 cc. Pressure increases with height of container.
- 5. Lower container 12 inches below level of rectum and drain solution back into container. To aid in expulsion of flatus.
- 6. Continue instilling and draining until all flatus is expelled. 15-20 minutes for maximum effect. Replace with clean warm solution as needed.
- 7. Clamp and slowly remove rectal tube and dispose. Drain rectum before discontinuing treatment.
- 8. Leave patient clean and comfortable.
- 9. Documentation: Chart on Nurses' Notes, when procedure done, how patient tolerated and results.
