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OR/MINOR PROCEDURES

(Scope)

TITLE: YAG LASER (SETTING UP AND BREAKING DOWN) PROCEDURE

PURPOSE: To define nursing responsibility in setting up and taking down of the Yag Laser for surgical

procedures in the OR.

SUPPORTIVE

DATA:

- 1. Lasers in the OR may be operated, including set up and break down, only by personnel properly trained via formalized instruction.
- 2. There are many hazards associated with the laser use of which all health care workers involved must be aware of and be knowledgeable in dealing with safely.

EQUIPMENT: Yag Laser OR II

- 1. YAG Laser Machine
- 2. Key locked in box in sub sterile room
- 3. Laser Signs
- 4. Laser fiber
- 5. Yag Laser Protective Glasses

CONTENT: PROCEDURE:

KEY POINTS:

Found in OR Room 2

- Obtain laser fiber
- 2. Cover window with shade
- 3. Place laser signs on all doors
- 4. Hang protective glasses on hook outside door
- 5. Have laser masks available at scrub sinks
- 6. Plug laser machine in OR room
- 7. Keep fire extinguishers available in OR (mount on back wall)
- Inspect all cords as you are plugging them in for intactness
- 9. Remove laser key from box and place in machine
- Turn key clockwise to ON and allow laser to warm up
- 11. Insert fiber into port
- After warm-up phase is over, switch to operate mode
- 13. Set watts at 30, depress foot pedal and carbonize fiber by placing it on a wooden tongue blade covered with surgical marker.
- 14. Change laser setting from operate to standby according to surgeon's usage and lower watts to 15w.
- After surgery, record joules and pulses used in Laser Log Book and on Operative Record before turning off machine
- 16. Also record on Operative Record that all safety precautions were in place.

Laser Log Book is kept on tope of laser machine

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- 17. Disconnect fiber from Yag laser machine and turn key to **off** position.
- 18. Return key to box for laser use.
- 19. Unplug laser machine from outlet
- 20. Remove laser safety signs from door and store on machine
- 21. Collect all laser safety glasses and return to their cases on side of machine
- 22. Return laser machine and pedal to corner of OR II

DOCUMENTATION: In Laser Log Book and on Operative Record please record:

- a. Joules
- b. Pulses
- c. Watts
- d. Mode
- e. Label which includes the patient's name, etc.
