## **PROCEDURE STEPS:**

- 1. Institute Hospital-wide Latex Allergy Policy found in the Administrative Manual and Care of Latex Sensitive/Allergic patient in SDS.
- 2. Obtain Latex Allergy Band (red). Place band on patient and Latex Allergy sign on stretcher.
- Screen all equipment that will come in contact with the patient during the procedure for latex content and remove from area.
- 4. Use non-latex sterile gloves.
- 5. Cover finger with op-site prior to attaching pulse oximeter probe.
- 6. Use Ethicon sutures without rubber stays.
- 7. Use unit dose xylocaine jelly.
- If allergy develops, remove suspected allergen and provide immediate care as directed by the physician.
