MINOR PROCEDURES

(Scope)

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LOOP EXCISION OF THE END TRANSFORMATION ZONE (LEETZ) TITLE:

PURPOSE: To outline the steps for assisting with a LEETZ procedure

SUPPORTIVE 1. For a more extensive and complete excision of cervical dysplasia DATA

- than can be obtained during an colposcopy
- 2. Indications:
 - Several abnormal paps a.
 - Cervical dysplasia b.
 - Unsatisfactory colposcopy C.

EQUIPMENT LIST: 1. Valley lab cautery machine with hand switch, grounding pad.

- Suction set-up with in-line filter. 2.
- Vaginal speculum with smoke port. 3.
- Various loops different sizes. 4.
- Surgical gloves (doctor's size). 5.
- Yellow gown if needed. 6.
- 7. Face mask/goggles as indicated.
- 8. Large cotton tipped applicators.
- 9. Sponge sticks.
- 10. 4 x 4's sterile tray.
- 11. Doctor's Choice:
 - a. Monsels solution
 - b. Acetic Acid 3%
 - c. Lugols solution
- 12. 10 cc syringe
- 13. 1 18g needle
 14. 3 ½" spinal needle 22g or 20g.
- 15. Lidocaine plain 1%
- 16. Valley Lab Accuvac (used by some)
- 17. Sanitary pad for patient post procedure

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CONTENT: PROCEDURE STEPS:

A. Pre-Procedure Assessment/Care

- 1. See Minor Procedure, Nursing Record Guideline, Admit patient take vital signs, etc.
- 2. Do pre-procedure teaching/obtain consent.
- 3. Place patient in lithotomy position on exam table for procedure.

B. During Procedure

- 1. Set up and assist doctor as necessary.
- 2. Monitor, assess patient throughout procedure and provide emotional support.

C. Post Procedure

- 1. Take vital signs and chart.
- 2. Assess patient for bleeding or any reaction to intracervical anesthesia and document.
- 3. Explain discharge instructions to patient and document patient's understanding of the instructions.
