Minor Procedures (Scope)

TITLE:

ADULT MYRINGOTOMY WITH TUBE INSERTION (ALSO CALLED TYMPANOTOMY)

PURPOSE:

To outline nursing role in adult myringotomy

EQUIPMENT LIST:

- 1. Myringotomy tray/speculum set green or yellow from OR.
- 2. Microscope with 200 x angled lens from OR.
- 3. Beaver Blade from OR.
- 4. Tube/s for ears (doctor's choice) from OR.
- 5. Sterile gloves.
- 6. Sterile towel pack.
- 7. Fenestrated drape.
- 8. Sterile Q tips.
- Sterile cotton balls.
- 10. Specimen cup with betadine.
- 11. T-B syringe.
- 12. Lidocaine usually 2% Plain (ask doctor).
- 13. 10 cc syringe, 18 g needle, 22 g 1 ½ needle off tray.

PROCEDURE:

A. Pre-Procedure Assessment/Care

- 1. Obtain consent
- Obtain patients medical/surgical history, current medications, and information pertaining to current complaint.
- Obtain baseline vital signs.
- 4. Explain sensations that patient is likely to experience.

B. Intraoperative Procedure Responsibilities

- 1. Reassure patient during procedure.
- Assist doctor as needed.
- 3. Document procedure and patient response to procedure.

C. Post Procedure Assessment/Care

- Assist patient as needed.
- 2. Take post procedure vital signs and document.
- 3. Reinforce doctors discharge instructions.
