TITLE: HEMMORHOIDAL BANDING OF INTERNAL HEMMORHOIDS/BANDING OF ESOPHAGEAL VARICES

**PURPOSE:** To outline the steps for assisting with endoscopic hemorrhoidal banding.

To outline the steps for assisting with Esophageal Varices Banding

**EQUIPMENT LIST:** 

1. Colonoscopy set up to do colonoscopy first

2. EGD scope

3. Speedband Superview 7

CONTENTS: PROCEDURE:

## A. Procedure – For Hemorrhoids

- 1. Patient is admitted as for all endoscopic procedures see colonoscopy 7430.015a.
- 2. A Colonoscopy is first done by the endoscopist.
- 3. The Speedband Superview 7 is assembled per manufacturer on the EGD scope by the nurse.
- While the patient is still sedated, 2 to 3 bands are placed by the endoscopist with a Speedband Superview 7 on the hemorrhoids.

## B. Procedure - For Esophageal Varices

- 1. Patient is admitted as for all Endoscopic procedures: see EGD 7430.025a.
- 2. An EGD is done by the Endoscopist
- 3. The Speed band Superview 7 is assembled per manufacture's instructions
- 4. While the patient is sedated, 2-3 bands are placed on the varicies by the Endoscopist.

## C. Post Procedure

- 1. Monitor per protocol/discharge
- 2. The physician may order a stool softener post procedure for hemorrhoidal banding, include in discharge instructions if indicated.
