TITLE: STANDARDS FOR PRACTICE FOR RN IN MINOR PROCEDURES

- 1. Performs the technical procedures required by the patient need/assignment without causing harm and consistent with one's own scope of practice and the hospital's legal constraints.
- 2. Initiates actions to insure continuity of effective care before, during and/or after the patient's contact with the hospital.
- 3. Documents actions and interventions, outcomes and responses, and/or assessment data consistent with the policy and procedures of the hospital.
- 4. Participates in activities to maintain and/or enhance the competent practice of self and others as defined by the Minor Procedures Competency Checklist and quiz, and consistent with the hospital's legal constraints.
- 5. Acts on behalf of patients before, during and/or after contact with the hospital to ensure that their rights and/or values are not compromised.
- 6. Initiates actions to prevent, correct, and/or reduce identified risks to individual' s health.
- 7. Uses internal and/or external resources to prevent, resolve, and/or minimizes patient/family health problems.
- 8. Provides evaluative evidence of effective, efficient, and/or satisfying care in the hospital.
- 9. Changes, continues or discontinues practice on the basis of evaluative evidence.
- 10. Uses communication or interpersonal skills with individuals and/or groups to achieve desired/intended outcomes and/or feelings of satisfaction/acceptance.
- 11. Supports actions/inactions/decisions with logical, ethical, legal, rationale and/or proven experience.
