TITLE: HALL MICRO 100 OSCILLATING SAW

PURPOSE: To outline procedure for proper use of Micro 100 Oscillating Saw.

A. To attach blade

1. Place the blade between the end of the output shaft and the compression washer

WARNING: Be sure the instrument control lever is placed in the "SAFE" position before inserting blades.

NOTE: Do not place the blade between the washer and the head of the screw.

B. To secure blade:

- 1. Tighten the lock screw with the hex wrench (1365-005).
- 2. Activate the instrument briefly and retighten the lock screw.

WARNING:

- 1. DO NOT exceed 100psi running.
- 2. Be certain saw blades are tightly secured before use.
- 3. The blades may be positioned at any angle.
