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TITLE: INSUFFLATORS SET UP AND USE

**PURPOSE:** To outline nursing responsibility in the use of the CO<sub>2</sub> insufflators in the OR.

**SUPPORTIVE DATA:** The CO<sub>2</sub> insufflators are used in the OR to instill the gas into the abdomen for better visibility during

endoscopic abdominal surgery.

**EQUIPMENT LIST:** 1. Storz Insufflator

CONTENT: PROCEDURE STEPS:

1. Plug into electrical outlet.

2. Turn power to insufflator ON.

3. Keep intra-abdominal pressure set at 12mm to 15mmHg (per surgeon's preference).

- Connect silastic tube to outlet indicated "To Patient", the other end to insufflating instrument.
- 5. Set Insufflate switch to ON for gas flow.
- When procedure is complete, set insufflate switch to OFF position.
- 7. To change gas tank follow these steps:
  - a. Make sure insufflator is OFF.
  - b. Using a wrench, turn valve on tank clockwise to seal used tank.
  - Remove tube housing and then remove old tank from cart.
  - d. Place new tank on cart, remove seal and firmly seat tube housing on tank.
  - e. Using a wrench, turn valve on tank counter clockwise to open new tank.

**KEY POINTS:** 

- 3. a. Volume tells total amount of gas flow.
  - b. Use or + on pressure selection to adjust pressure.
