#### AFTERNOON DUTIES

#### 1. After each room is finished with cases:

- Put away any equipment that was used.
- Loop and hang all extension cords.
- Place ring stands, mayo stands, prep tables, stools, trash and linen containers against the walls
- Turn off all electrical equipment
- Turn off all lights.
- Shut the door.
- 2. Stock each substerile room with the following:
  - Sterile water and sterile saline (in warmer)
  - Blankets (in the warmer)
  - Suction canisters, tops and tandems
  - Specimen containers (filled and empty and properly labeled)
- 3. Review the next day's schedule with either the charge nurse or the float nurse, planning for patient transport needs and the equipment in each room.
- 4. Set up rooms for the next day whenever possible.
