TITLE:	CLEANING AND I	HANDLING OF INSTRUMENT AT THE END OF	EACH CASE BY	THE SCRUB NURSE

**PURPOSE**: Procedure for the scrub nurse as to care of instruments at the end of each case.

## CONTENT: PROCEDURE:

## A. General Instruments

- 1. All soiled instruments are to be opened and sprayed with enzyme cleaner.
- 2. Clean instruments are to go back into their appropriate set container with the lid place on top.
- 3. Separate any fine OR delicate instruments and place them into an emesis basin.

## B. Cameras, Scopes and Cords

1. All are to be wiped and cords are to be wound up and placed back into their appropriate containers with the lids placed on top.

# C. Cystoscopes, Uteteroscopes, etc:

- 1. Dismantle all pieces, rinse with water.
- 2. All ports are to be opened and placed back into their appropriate container.
- 3. All small items are to be placed back into their container or into an emesis basin.

## D. Laparoscopy Instruments and GYN related Instruments

- 1. Dismantle all pieces and place back into their appropriate container.
- 2. All small items are to be placed back into their container or into an emesis basin.
- 3. Any trochars are to be dismantled and placed into their appropriate container or an emesis basin.

# E. Drills and Saws

- 1. Dismantle batteries and all attachments
- 2. Wipe hand pieces clean
- 3. Run water through drill hole and all attachments only.
- 4. Wipe batteries clean
- 5. Place everything back into their container or an emesis basin if no container is available.
- 6. Do not submerse any hand pieces or batteries.

## F. Eye Instruments

- 1. All instruments are to be wiped and placed back into their container with the lid on top.
- 2. All tips, IA pieces and Phaco hand pieces are rinsed through with water in a syringe, then air in a syringe.
