TITLE: DISPENSING MEDICATIONS AND SOLUTIONS DURING SURGERY

PURPOSE: To insure delivery of correct medication and accurate dosage. Al medications will be

dispensed and/or administered by a registered nurse or a physician. Aseptic conditions will be

maintained at all times.

CONTENT: PROCEDURE:

1. Labels of medications and solutions should be checked.

- a. Three (3) times
- b. When taking from shelf, drawer or cart
- c. After dispensing
- d. Proper dosage
- e. Expiration date
- 2. Labels of medication or solutions should be shown to "scrub" personnel before dispensing so they will know what medication; dosage/strength and expiration date is on the sterile field.
- 3. All medication/solutions on a sterile field will have a sterile label. Those not labeled should not be used in the event of relief or shift change.
- 4. Any solutions that are not labeled as sterile and in a sterile container shall not be used on a sterile field.
- 5. Once sterile caps have been removed from the sterile solution bottles, they cannot be replaced and be considered sterile.
