TITLE:

OPERATING ROOM ATTIRE

- 1. All personnel entering restricted areas of the surgical suite are required to wear Operating Room apparel supplied by the hospital. This apparel is made of a fabric which meets the National Fire Protection Association standards and laundered in a facility monitored by HCH.
- 2. All possible head and facial hair must be covered by a clean scrub hat or hood.
- 3. All personnel will wear high filtration efficiency disposable masks in the Operating Rooms and substerile areas during surgery except during some urological procedures.
- 4. Shoe covers will be worn in restricted areas of the surgical suite. Shoe covers are not required if shoes are not worn outside the O.R.
- 5. Soiled attire should be changed as soon as possible. Masks should be changed after every case. Shoe covers should not be worn outside the O.R. and should be changed daily.
- 6. Jewelry is to be totally confined within scrub attire. Rings, watches, or bracelets should be removed before hand washing. Fingernails are kept short. Tips but no artificial nails are permitted.
- 7. Eye protection is to be worn by all members of the surgical team.
- 8. Any person leaving the O.R. should cover scrub suits with a clean buttoned lab coat. If a lab coat is not worn, a complete change of scrub attire is required before re-entering the O.R.
- 9. Standard precautions are implemented whenever there is a risk of exposure to infective materials.
