## **NURSING RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Supervisors and directs patient care in an individual operating room.
  - a. Ensure that proper techniques and practices are used according to accepted standards of practice.
  - b. Supervises other personnel in the room and directs or assists as necessary.
  - c. Ensures care of patient through proper identification, checking of chart and reporting of changes in condition.
  - d. Immediately reports any unusual occurrences to charge personnel and documents appropriately in the patient record.
- 2. Performs scrub duties as assigned.
- 3. Maintains count of sponges, needles and instruments to ensure no loss of items according to present protocol.
- 4. Performs all circulating duties with efficiency and speed.
  - a. Supervises and assist scrub technician
  - b. Positions patient and prepares operative area
  - c. Has all supplies and equipment in room and provides to team as necessary
  - d. Opens all sterile packs and supplies according to aseptic technique
  - e. Assists surgeons, anesthesiologist and other personnel as needed to ensure good patient care.
  - f. Observes patient for changes in condition
  - g. Reviews surgeons' preference cards for desired medications and supplies. Verifies same with surgeon.
  - h. Ensures all medications are administered and charted according to established protocols and procedures.
  - i. Identifies and records patient's repose to medication where necessary
  - j. Ensures that all double-check medications policies are followed.
  - k. Refers to resource material where ever necessary
  - I. Promptly reports medication errors
  - m. Cares for specimens and cultures as directed by set policies and procedures.
  - n. Maintains records of procedure and records and reports any unusual occurrences
  - o. Provides orderly progression of schedule by sending for following patients at proper times and notifies charge personnel of any changes.
  - p. Accompanies patient to PACU and reports to nurse on patient, procedure and special happenings to ensure continuity of care.
- 5. Provides for continuity of individual patient care
  - Receives and gives reports to and about patient as necessary to ensure good care.
  - b. Provides for psychological needs of patient.
- 6. Assists in control and maintenance of supplies and equipment.
  - a. Records used items in proper place and method directed.
  - b. Reports and records any lack or discrepancies in items.

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- 7. Assists in administrative duties as directed.
  - a. Helps with maintenance of records and statistics
  - b. Assists in establishment and maintenance of procedure and protocols.
- 8. Assists in supervision of personnel and department to provide optimum assurance of safe environment.
  - a. Checks rooms, materiel and equipment for proper care and handling.
  - b. Ensures clean, safe environment through continued alertness to safety and explosive hazards and aseptic techniques.
  - c. Assists in control of traffic and personnel to ensure proper control of infection and asepsis.
- 9. Assists in operating room staff development and education.
  - a. Assists in formulation and interpretation of procedures, protocols and techniques
  - b. Assists in orientation of new personnel
  - c. Assists in evaluation of all OR activities, nursing care given and of personnel and techniques.
  - d. Avails his or herself in the ongoing nursing education process of the hospital
  - e. Review pertinent periodicals, scientific and medical and related literature.
- 10. On-call for emergencies and available for additional duty.
- 11. Accountability and Adaptability
  - a. Assumes accountability and responsibility for his or her own work performance and those under his or her supervision.
  - b. Observes assigned working schedules and hours
  - c. Performs competently in new situations
  - d. Performs competently in emergencies
- 12. Adheres to operating dress code; neat personal appearance
- 13. Personal Relations
  - a. Maintains good rapport with fellow employees
  - b. Maintains good rapport with physicians.
  - c. Performs his or her duties in a professional and pleasant manner.
