PURPOSE

Manual muscle testing is a form of isokinetic/isometric exercise and principles. It provides an objective data base for volitional movement. Grading follows set standards.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Patient must be relaxed and aware that their strength is being tested. Test the uninvolved side of body first.
- 2. Test the isolated muscle at its best mechanical advantage.
- 3. Take the joint through passive range of motion first; then proceed with active or resistive movement.
- 4. Check for sub situations.
- 5. Follow grades of zero (0), trace (1), poor (2), fair (3), good (4), or normal (5).
