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## **POLICY**

A patient's progress is continually monitored and their status reevaluated in preparation for discharge. The discharge is discussed with the patient and discharge plans and instructions are clear prior to discharge.

## **PROCEDURE**

Patients receiving therapy will be discharged from Physical and/or Occupational Therapy under the following conditions:

- 1. The patient/therapy goal(s) has been reached.
- 2. The patient who has been receiving therapy is scheduled for surgery. New therapy orders are required after surgery.
- 3. The patient has been involved in an incident; i.e., a fall, stat procedure.
- 4. A physician puts the patient on hold.
- 5. The patient is no longer making functional progress in therapy.

For inpatients, the ordering physician should be notified of lack of progress and reason for termination of services.

For outpatients, a discharge summary report will be completed and sent to referring physician.
